

# ADDING AND SUBTRACTING DECIMALS

- When adding and subtracting decimals, the decimal points and each of the decimal places must be aligned under one another.
- The location of the decimal point in the answer is directly in line with the location of each of the decimal points in the question.
- Once the numbers are aligned correctly, proceed as if completing whole number addition or subtraction.
- If the numbers of decimal places in the numbers being added or subtracted are different, it is helpful to place additional zeros in the shorter number(s) to prevent calculation errors.

# ADDING AND SUBTRACTING DECIMALS

$$\begin{array}{r} 18.31 \\ + 5.93 \\ \hline 14.24 \end{array}$$



Put decimal points under one another.  
Fill missing decimal places with **zeros**.  
Add, using the procedure for whole numbers.

$$\begin{array}{r} 1614.800 \\ 3.012 \\ + 5.940 \\ \hline 73.752 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 5.83 \\ - 3.12 \\ \hline 2.71 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 13151 \\ \cancel{146}.35 \\ - 79.50 \\ \hline 66.85 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 81 \\ 24.\cancel{90} \\ - 3.52 \\ \hline 21.38 \end{array}$$
