USING FORMULAS - REARRANGING FORMULAS

The subject of a formula is a pronumeral that usually sits on its own on the left-hand side.

Example: C is the subject of the formula $C = 2 \pi r$

A formula can be rearranged to make another pronumeral the subject

Example: $C = 2 \pi r$ can be rearranged as $r = -\frac{1}{2}$

$$r = \frac{C}{2\pi}$$
